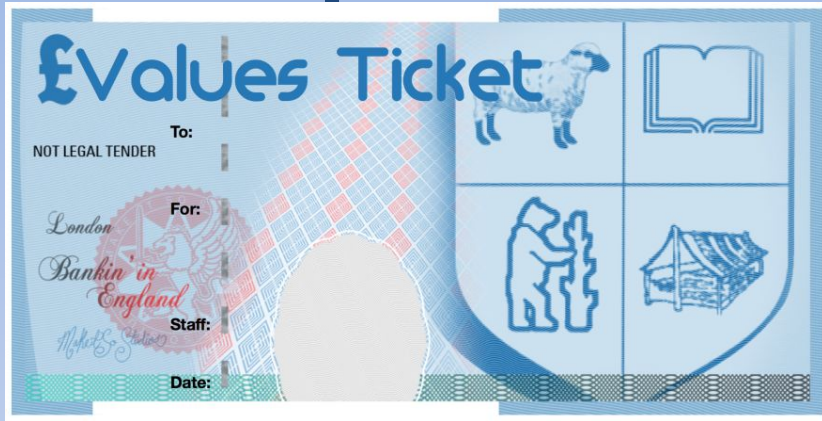
This can't be activated until your child has started school.
